- **We do not support alternative vaccine schedules; A delayed schedule puts the individual child and their contact at risk for developing serious illnesses.**

- Delaying or skipping vaccines increases the risk of preventable diseases, especially for vulnerable populations like infants, immunocompromised children, and the elderly.
- Maintaining a fully vaccinated patient population helps protect our entire community.

- Please bring your child to each visit. Starting at Birth, 1-,2-,4-,6-,9-,15-,18- and 24-month checkups and yearly after that.
- Stay informed about upcoming vaccines and booster requirements.
